

Elements of Literature Five-Paragraph Essay

Two documents:

o Create an outline and save it to your English folder as: *Elements of Literature Outline* (incorrectly named files, for any assignment, result in a loss of credit... FOLLOW DIRECTIONS)

o Final draft, saved to your English folder as: *Elements of Literature Essay*

(Write your rough draft and then final draft in your notebook. You are not to sit at a computer and write this essay from scratch. If you're sitting at a computer, I will ask you to show me your hand-written final draft if I don't see it in front of you. This will help you write in drafts and best share our in-class technology.)

How To:

- Using your notes, and respecting the *Five-Paragraph Essay Format* and *Five-Paragraph Essay Rubric*, write a five-paragraph essay, the topic being: *Literary Elements in (your film)*

- Pick three (3) Literary Elements from the Elements of Literature document. These will be your three subtopics (one per body paragraph).

- Focus on writing a solid introduction and conclusion for the other two paragraphs.

- *Proofread* and have others proofread your essay for mechanics (spelling, grammar, punctuation, formal voice, etc.), being certain to avoid what is mentioned on the *Five-Paragraph Essay Format* document.

To receive full credit, fully earn it.
