

Yearbook Page(s) Rubric

- All images on page must have facial recognition for ALL people pictured.
- All images must have captions – NO exceptions.
 - All captions must be thoughtful, creative, not obvious.
- Each page have at least one quote/photo of quoted person.
- Sports pages must include both a photo and quote from the coach or coaches (if more than one coach, ALL the coaches must be pictured).
- Images must be zoomed it or adapted to best fit page. Useless white space or background must be minimized for the focus to be solely on the subject. At times you may offset a subject or be creative for effect, but that effect must be apparent and not an accident that is later rationalized.
- Research and add quotes and/or other content to make the page more interesting. For example: "There is no bench in cross country."
- All group/team shots must have a caption in which all participants/members must be noted AND spelled EXACTLY right. Precede names with (b-f) and (l-r) on all group shots.
- All team pages must contain 100% correct season W/L stats. It's your job to get that data.
- SHOW CREATIVITY – Use an interesting template. Use as many photos as possible. Take advantage of templates' preformatted text to make it POP.
- Credit all non-staff (this includes the school photographer) images to those who took them. Put the credits at the bottom as in the xcountry proof, NOT next to the image(s).
- A deadline is a deadline. There will be no extensions, especially considering you can do this work at home or anywhere you have Internet access. If you miss a deadline, you receive no credit but still are responsible for completing the work as expected above.

Failure to complete ALL of the above results in an incomplete grade of 50%. Grades can be even lower based on the overall quality and effort shown.
